The aim of this scholarship which the ESOLSIG committee set up, is to honour and award unsung ESOL heroes who have gone above and beyond in terms of their hard work and dedication to the field of teaching English to speakers of other languages.

## *The scholarship consists of:*

- Registration for the ESOL Pre-Conference Event
- Registration for the IATEFL Conference
- 1 night's accommodation (receipts necessary)
- GBP 30.00 expenses
- Travel expenses up to the value of GBP 150.00 (receipts necessary)

## To qualify, you must:

- Have contributed to the field of ESOL in such a way that it has been noticed, noted, and admired by colleagues. These contributions may include dedication to the field, hard work, materials or curriculum development, teacher training and collegiality.
- Have not previously attended an ESOLSIG's Pre-conference event.
- Be working in the field of ESOL teaching immigrants, displaced people, asylum seekers, and refugees.
- Be prepared to contribute to the ESOLSIG's newsletter ESOL Matters.
- Be prepared to be interviewed and featured on the ESOLSIG's website.

## *To be considered you must submit:*

- The names and emails of four colleagues who will contact ESOLSIG via email to nominate you as ESOL Champion.
- The four colleagues listed must email <u>esolsig@iatefl.org</u> explaining why they think you deserves the Champion award.

The submission deadline is **16.00 (UK time) on Wednesday 21 June 2023**. Early submissions are very welcome; late submissions will not be considered.

The result of your application will be emailed to you between **7 and 21 August 2023**. Please do NOT contact the IATEFL Head Office about scholarship decisions; the Scholarship Committee will send everyone the results as soon as they are available.
