The aim of the scholarship is to help one member of the Research SIG to attend the IATEFL Conference and our Pre-Conference Event (ReSIG PCE).

The scholarship consists of:

- IATEFL ReSIG Membership (as full individual membership or additional SIG)
- Registration for the ReSIG Pre-Conference Event
- Registration for the IATEFL Conference
- GBP 800 towards conference-related expenses

To qualify you must:

- Be a current IATEFL member, with ReSIG as your primary SIG
- Not have been awarded the ReSIG scholarship before
- Agree to write a 1000-2000-word report about your PCE Conference experience for *ELT Research*, the SIG's newsletter

To be considered you must submit:

- A 200-250-word statement describing your interest in teacher research
- A 60-100-word bio

The submission deadline is **16.00 (UK time) on Wednesday 21 June 2023**. Early submissions are very welcome; late submissions will not be considered.

The result of your application will be emailed to you between **7 and 21 August 2023**. Please do NOT contact the IATEFL Head Office about scholarship decisions; the Scholarship Committee will send everyone the results as soon as they are available.
