



IATEFL Bill Lee Scholarship

The Bill Lee Scholarship Fund was set up in memory of our late Founder Chair by generous donations from the many people who knew him. The aim of the scholarship is to help IATEFL members in the countries where Bill had worked (see below) to attend the IATEFL Conference and give a presentation. The scholarship is financed by the interest on the Fund.

The scholarship consists of:

- registration for a Pre-Conference Event of the winner's choice
- registration for the IATEFL Conference
- GBP 1000.00 towards conference related costs

To qualify you must:

- be a native of and normally resident in one of the following countries: Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland, Romania, Slovakia
- be an Individual, Student, Retired, Early Career Teacher or Basic member of IATEFL
- agree to give a presentation at the IATEFL Conference
- agree to write a 250 - 500-word article by the end of May 2025 for possible publication in IATEFL Voices. You may like to write about the highlights of the conference or about how attending the conference has affected your approach to work in your home country.

To be considered, you must submit:

- an online speaker proposal by the scholarship deadline
- an essay of between 400 and 500 words:
 - outlining your teaching context
 - describing a recent successful lesson you have given
 - listing the factors that made it successful
 - drawing a broad conclusion regarding your future teaching practice.

The submission deadline is **14.00 (UK time) on Wednesday 19 June 2024**. Early submissions are very welcome; late submissions will not be considered.

The result of your application will be emailed to you between **12 and 23 August 2024**. Please do NOT contact the IATEFL Head Office about scholarship decisions; the Scholarship Committee will send everyone the results as soon as they are available.
